



SHEPARDS WHARF MARINA DRAGON ARRANGEMENTS

ARRIVAL

- 'Arrival Day' is Saturday 8 July. However, your earlier arrival - Thursday 6 or Friday 7 – will be most welcome and is encouraged!
- Access to Shepards Wharf Marina is from 0800 to 1900 daily – please see the diagram for entrance/exit.
- If your arrival is outside 0800-1900 – phone Mark Hart who will come to the marina to let you in.

- On arrival please drive in. Unhitch your boat in the 'Boat Drop Off Zone', as shown. The Marina Crew will then move your boat to the rigging area.
- Having unhitched your boat - **You are asked to IMMEDIATELY to drive out and park your car elsewhere. Please note, it is NOT possible to park in the marina.** There is a small public paying car park opposite the 'entrance' to Shepards Wharf, the Brunswick Road Car Park. Alternatively, a bit further afield you can find roadside parking.

CAR PARKING

- The Trustees of Northwood House have generously offered FREE car parking for the duration of the regattas.
- This will be one car per Dragon and a Parking Permit card will be available at Registration on a first come first served basis (we have a total of 35 passes to issue). The permit runs from 7 to 15 July inclusive.
- Northwood House Car Park (lower car park entrance), Park Road, opposite junction with Terminus Road

MARSHALLS - Some Cowes Dragon sailors will be on hand to welcome & assist you with fast rigging etc!

RIGGING & CRANING

To minimise Crane delays, or queues – please be 'CRANE READY' before being moved under the crane. I.e.

- Lifting Strop in place
- Back Stay and Runners off/forward
- Bow and Stern lines in place
- Bung/screwdriver ready to go

ONLY when 'CRANE READY' will you be moved to the Crane area.

Please note that time for Keel Polishing will be MINIMAL, particularly if there are boats waiting to launch.

The Marina boat crew will undertake the craning for you and will have RIB assistance on standby to take you to your berth.

DRAGON BERTHING

The Dragon berthing area is shown on the diagram. There is no assigned position for each boat so go where you wish. It may be necessary for boats to berth alongside each other, up to 3 boats abreast.

ISLAND SAILING CLUB LAUNCH SHUTTLE SERVICE

- The ISC Launch Shuttle Service will operate before and after racing on every race day
- It is hoped that ISC launches, and other RIBS, will be available to take you directly from the Marina to the ISC for Registration from craning in.

HOISTING & DEPARTURE

- There is NO Craning on Friday 14 July.
- Hoisting for Departure will commence from 0800 on Saturday 15 July.
